

# Competition Terms and Conditions



# Play Hard, Play Fair

*and Stay in the Game*

## Introduction

1. These terms and conditions are the competition rules (the "Rules") that apply to Play Hard Play Fair and Stay in the Game (the "Competition").
2. The Competition is organised by the England and Wales Cricket Board Limited (the "ECB") who is also the promoter of the Competition.
3. These Rules will apply unless otherwise expressly stated or varied by the ECB.
4. A copy of these Rules will be posted on the ECB website at [www.ecb.co.uk/playhardplayfair](http://www.ecb.co.uk/playhardplayfair) (the "ECB Website").
5. The ECB reserves the right to cancel the Competition or to amend these Rules at any time without notice. Notification of cancellation or any amendment(s) will be posted on the ECB Website.

7. In the event of any dispute regarding these Rules or otherwise relating to the Competition, the decision of the ECB shall be final.

## Entrants

8. The Competition is only open to UK Residents. Except employees and other staff working for the ECB or their agents, families and anyone else professionally associated with the competition. By registering for and entering the Competition, each Entrant confirms that he/she meets the entry criteria. Each Entrant who is under 16, also confirms that he/she has the permission of his/her parent or guardian to enter the Competition and to be bound by these Rules. Proof of eligibility to enter the competition may be required.
9. A person who registers for the Competition (an "Entrant"), completes all of the Play Hard Play Fair and Stay in the Game questions correctly shall be automatically entered into the prize draw.
10. By registering for and participating in the Competition, Entrants agree to be bound by these Rules.
11. The ECB reserves the right to verify the eligibility of any Entrant. The ECB further reserves the right to disqualify any Entrant if, in the opinion of the ECB, such Entrant has breached any of these Rules or otherwise acted improperly or dishonestly.
12. Employees of the ECB and any individual directly or indirectly associated with the operation of the Competition are not eligible to be entered into the prize draw.

## Competition entries

13. The Competition involves the use of a telephone, mobile phone or the internet and each Entrant confirms that he/she has permission to use such devices.
14. Entrants who wish to be entered into the prize draw must complete the Competition by no later than midnight on 1st August 2015 (the "Closing Date"). Any entry made after the Closing Date will not be entered into the prize draw. The ECB will not accept responsibility for failing to receive any entry by the Closing Date as a result of a delay or failure in delivery, transmission or otherwise (howsoever caused).

15. Any damaged, incomplete or illegible registration forms or corrupted web pages will be invalid.
16. Each Entrant can make a maximum of one entry to the prize draw. No purchase is necessary to enter the Competition.

## Prizes

17. The Competition prizes are four pairs of tickets for the NatWest T20 Blast Finals Day at Edgbaston on August 29th 2015
18. Prize winners will be drawn at random by the ECB on 3rd August 2015.
19. Prize winners will be notified of their prizes by e-mail after the Closing Date. The tickets will be sent to a postal address provided by the winner. Each Entrant hereby agrees that the name and town/city of residence of prize winners may be published on the ECB Website.
20. If a prize winner fails to claim a prize within the time specified in the ECB's prize notification, the prize winner will automatically forfeit his/her prize and another prize winner will be selected.
21. Prizes are awarded at the ECB's discretion and no prize will be awarded to any Entrant who, in the opinion of the ECB, has breached any of these Rules or otherwise acted improperly or dishonestly.
22. The ECB reserves the right to substitute competition prizes at any time [with prizes of equal or greater value]. Prizes are non-transferable and there is no cash alternative.
23. Any ticket which forms part or all of any prize shall be provided to the prize winner for use strictly subject to the terms and conditions of such ticket.
24. The winner of the prize under the age of 18 must be accompanied to the match by an adult.
25. The ECB reserves the right to request appropriate/ independently certified proof of age of any prize winner.
26. The ECB shall have no liability whatsoever for any costs or expenses incurred by any Entrant as a result of his/her participation in the Competition or for attending any match if he/she is a prize winner.

## General

27. The ECB will not accept any liability whatsoever for any damage, loss or disappointment suffered by an Entrant as a result of entering the Competition or accepting any prize.
28. Winners may be required to participate in some publicity. Entrants agree that all rights in any publicity photographs and materials will belong to the ECB and may be used for promoting the ECB, its sponsors, partners and/or their respective goods or services or in the promotion of cricket. Entrants will have no right to any payment for taking part in such publicity.
29. The Competition and these Rules are governed by English law.

## Use of personal data

30. Each Entrant, by entering the Competition, consents to the processing of his/her personal data by the ECB for the operation of the Competition (including the administration of the prize draw) and as otherwise provided for pursuant to these Rules.
